- Reporting periods are calendar years.

- Retention rates are calculated as the percentage of students enrolled in the same program/Concentration at year end and did not graduate.
- Graduation rates are based on tracking student cohorts through 150% of normal time for program completion. Students are counted only if their first degree-seeking enrollment at the student level/institution occurred in a reported program/Concentration. Students must complete the same program/Concentration to be counted.
