Limitations and Restrictions

 Courses accepted in transfer may not be applicable to the academic program chosen by the student.
- The number of credits granted for any course equivalency may not exceed the number on the transcript associated with the transfer course.
- Curriculum changes at either institution may affect transferability and applicability of certain credits.
 A time limit may be imposed on the ability to transfer credits for some courses, especially those in technical or evolving areas.
