A scholarship to fuel your future

DeVry University is offering a scholarship match of up to \$2,250 for qualifying students who are awarded a Delta scholarship* and choose to pursue a certificate or degree program at DeVry University.

The DeVry University Delta Match Scholarship is designed to help make it more affordable to earn your degree or certificate, and to fuel your future accomplishments on your path through college.

- Awards of up to \$2,250 for qualifying students who are awarded a scholarship through the Delta Scholarship Fund.
- Recipients must be new, alumni or readmit¹ students who enroll in a certificate or degree program at DeVry by the November 2025 session.
- Delta employees and dependents may apply for the Delta Scholarship by January 31, 2025.

¹Readmit student is defined as a student who has previously attended DeVry University but has not been enrolled in courses during the past 12 months or longer.

²Those interested in a 4-credit-hour course may enroll. 3 credit hours would be complimentary, and the student will be responsible for the tuition of the remaining credit hour. Students are responsible for all other fees and charges, including books and Learning Management System (LMS) fees. Other restrictions apply, visit <http://partner.devry.edu/delta> for more details.

³Dependents who may benefit from family tuition savings and apply for the Delta Scholarship include: spouse, biological child, stepchild, legally adopted child, child for whom the employee is a court appointed guardian, child of a domestic partner, and adoptive or biological parents of the eligible employee. Dependents are also defined as a domestic partner in a committed long-term relationship. Neither party can be legally married to other individuals. Adoptive or biological parents of the eligible employee can also be classified as Dependents.

Overview

DeVry University is offering a scholarship match of up to \$2,250 for qualifying students who are awarded a Delta scholarship* and who enroll as new, readmit¹ or alumni students in a certificate or degree program at DeVry University. Requirements and Selection Process	Final Selection	Students will be notified by Delta in May or June 2025, if they were selected for the scholarship. 	Process Timeline	January 31st, 2025: Deadline for internal Delta Scholarship Application. March 2025 - November 2025: Students may enroll at DeVry University. May/June 2025: Delta notifies their internal scholarship award recipients. July 2025: Delta provides DeVry the list of scholarship recipients and their award amounts. August 2025: Delta provides internal scholarship award to the student. November 2025: Deadline for scholarship recipients to start classes. Spring 2026 Semester: First DeVry Delta Matching Scholarship award disbursement.

Award Structure	Qualifying students may receive up to \$2,250 (maximum lifetime award). The DeVry Delta Matching Scholarship award recipients will receive this amount for up to one year. The award will be paid out across three semesters, beginning the Spring 2026 Semester. Below is a chart outlining the scholarship award amounts and the semesters they would be awarded.
