

# The Foundever DeVry University Scholarship

We're excited to introduce another opportunity available to you through Foundever's partnership with DeVry University—a scholarship award designed to help you reach for what you want as a Foundever employee.

## A Scholarship to Fuel Your Future

Current full-time employees who have six consecutive months (to be eligible for \$5,000 award) or 12 consecutive months (to be eligible for \$10,000 award) of employment in good standing at Foundever are eligible to apply for the Foundever DeVry University Scholarship.<sup>1</sup>

This scholarship program is designed to help fuel the future of up to five students enrolled in the May or July 2024 session.

- Up to \$10,000 (maximum lifetime award) plus a complimentary laptop<sup>2</sup> for one new bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduate students
- Up to \$5,000 (maximum lifetime award) plus a complimentary laptop<sup>2</sup> for four new or readmit associate, bachelor's or master's degree-seeking undergraduate or graduate students

Books and fees are the responsibility of the student.</li> <li>The scholarship cannot be used in combination with other DeVry University group-specific tuition rates, including military or any other DeVry savings programs, except the Foundever Partner Tuition Savings of 30%.</li> <li>Continuing students are not eligible.</li> <li>Associates degree, Master's Degree and Readmit undergraduate or graduate degrees are not eligible for the \$10,000 scholarship.</li> <li>Undergraduate certificate and graduate certificate students are not eligible.</li> <li>Partial scholarship funds are not awarded to students who do not meet continued eligibility requirements.</li> <li>Scholarship funds unused at the point of graduation, or as a result of the student's ineligibility for continued participation for any reason, will remain undischursed, and will never result in a monetary refund to the student</li> </ul>				
Award Guidelines, Structure and Process	Disbursement	The scholarship award will be divided into either three or six disbursements of \$1,667 per semester. The \$10,000 scholarship award winner will receive this amount each semester for up to 2 years. \$5,000 scholarship award winners will receive this amount each semester for up to one year. Students would receive their first disbursement in the Summer 2024 semester.			
	Continued Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Undergraduate students must maintain at least a 2.5 CGPA or better.</li> <li>Graduate students must maintain at least a 3.0 CGPA or better.</li> <li>Graduate students must remain enrolled 4 out of 6 sessions in their scholarship period</li> <li>Undergraduate students can only fall below 9 credit hours once or take one semester off and maintain scholarship eligibility; student must return in the subsequent semester and meet the continuing eligibility threshold or they will lose their scholarship award</li> </ul>			
Foundever Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be a full-time employee and be in good standing with Foundever for 12 consecutive months to be eligible for the \$10,000 award or 6 consecutive months for the \$5,000 award.</li> <li>Remain employed at Foundever with no written disciplinary reports.</li> </ul>
