

DeVry University Undergraduate Tuition, Fees and Expenses: Matriculated Students, Except Onsite Students in New Jersey Effective July 2017 Session through May 2018 Session

Tuition rates shown are applicable to matriculating students enrolling in sessions beginning in July 2017 through May 2018. Within each session, matriculated students are charged at the per-credit-hour tuition rate of \$609 for non-TechPath degree programs or \$487 for TechPath degree programs and certificate programs as shown below.
