Assessment Results:

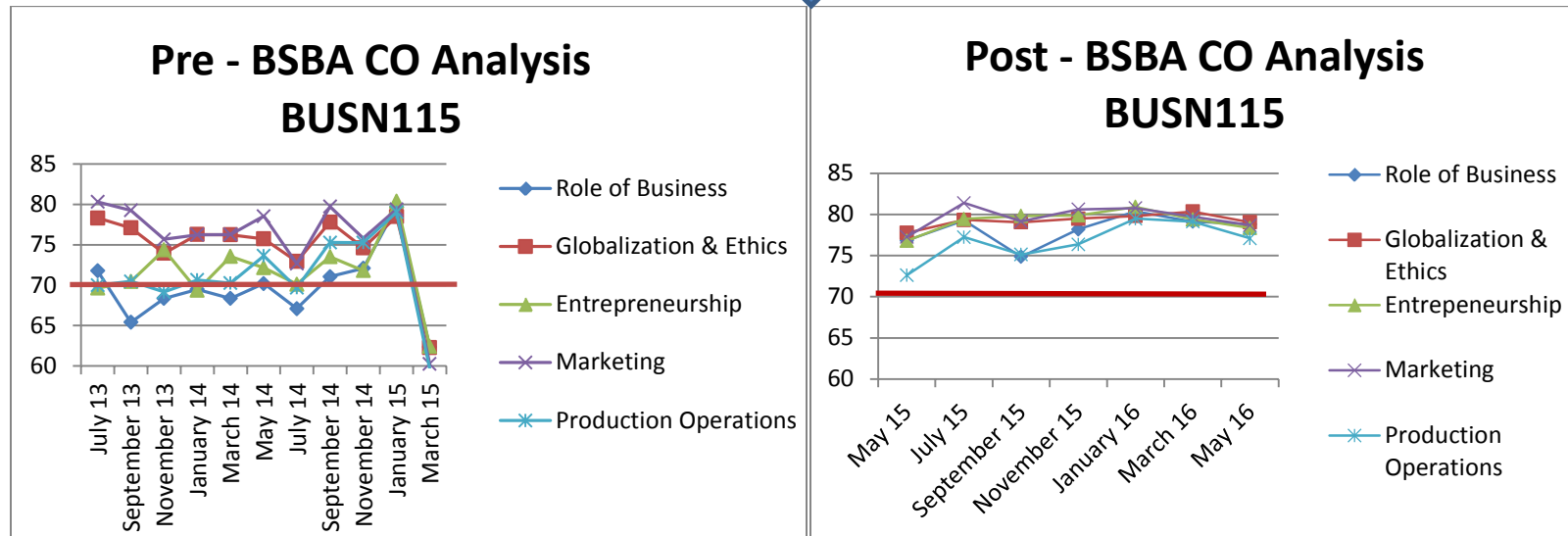
DeVry University uses course-level assessments to analyze student learning outcomes. DeVry University uses the Learning Outcomes Manager (LOM), our Learning Management System's central repository for storing, managing and analyzing the College of Business & Management's learning outcomes, and a collection of tools for defining and deploying assessment rubrics. DeVry University currently is assessing 49 courses across four undergraduate programs and eight graduate programs. The College's learning outcomes assessment committee and the assessment coordinator have identified the courses for assessing program objectives. To date, sufficient data points have been collected in the assessment of program objectives to allow faculty committees to create improvement recommendations.

The LOM internal benchmarks used to determine the need for faculty committees to review course content based on student performance are 70% at the undergraduate level and 80% at the graduate level. Course objectives assessed at a level more than 10% below the metric, are referred to the appropriate committee for analysis and course-specific improvement recommendations based on LOM based results.

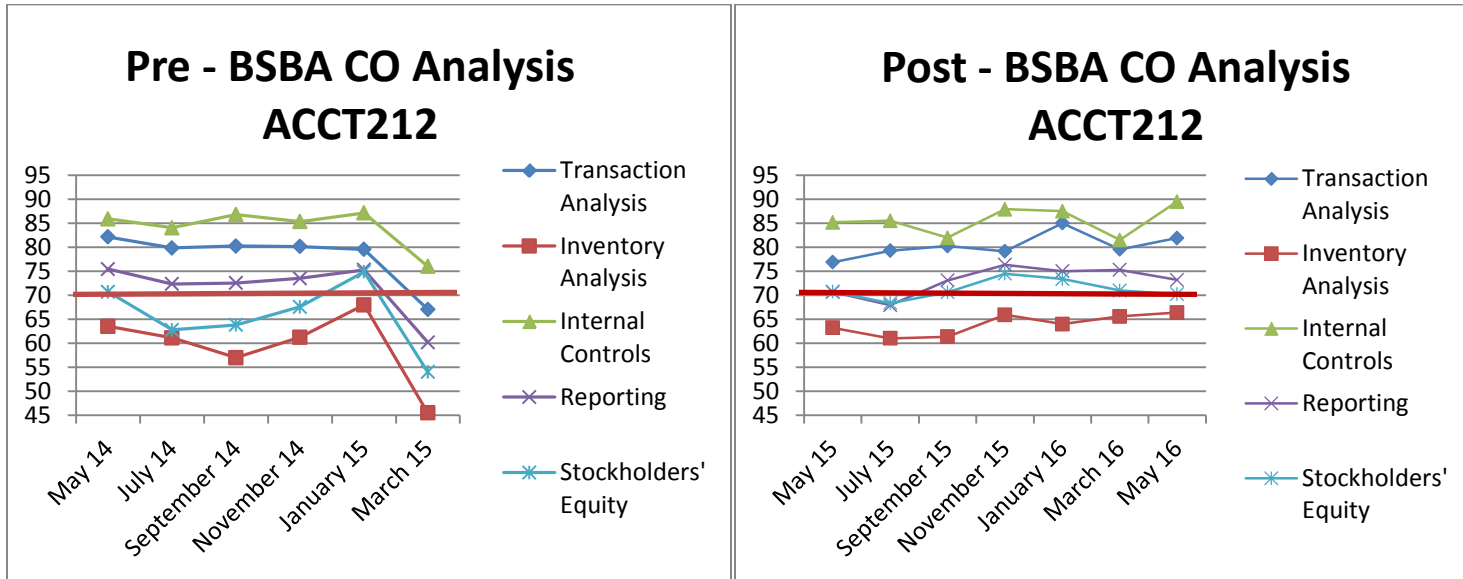
The following charts are examples of course level assessments for the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA) and the Master of Science in Business Administration (MBA) programs. The chart on the left includes data points for the course objectives (CO) for a particular course during a specified time frame. The chart on the right includes data points for COs for a particular course after faculty have reviewed the data in the chart and made curriculum recommendations.

The charts on the right for each of the below courses show significant improvements above the benchmarks for each of the course objectives after curriculum changes had been applied. DeVry University will continue to monitor the assessment results and revisit the benchmarks to help build students to a higher level. Faculty will continue to review assessment data and more curriculum changes have been recommended and will be applied.

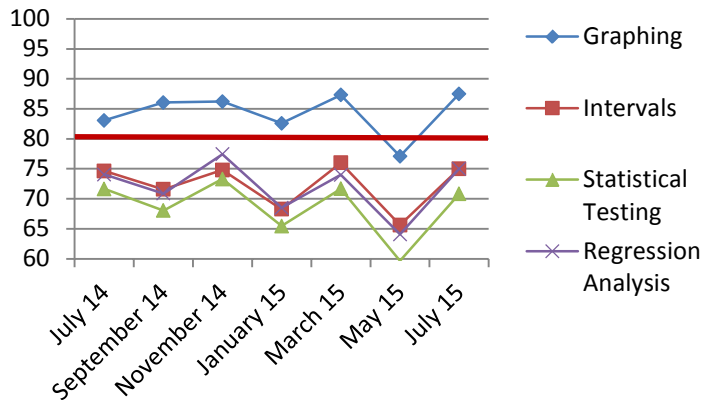

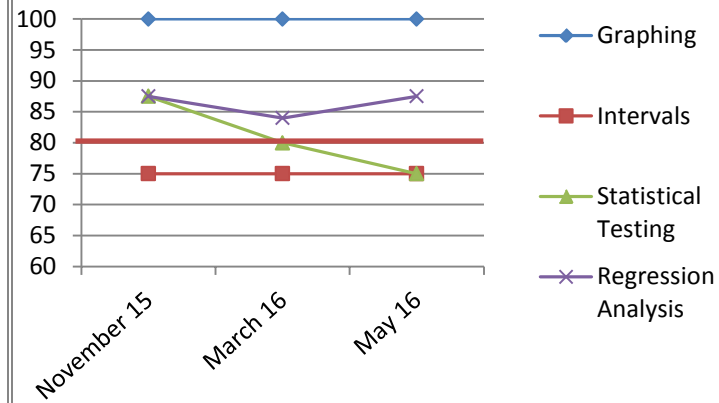

Pre - MBA CO Analysis MATH533



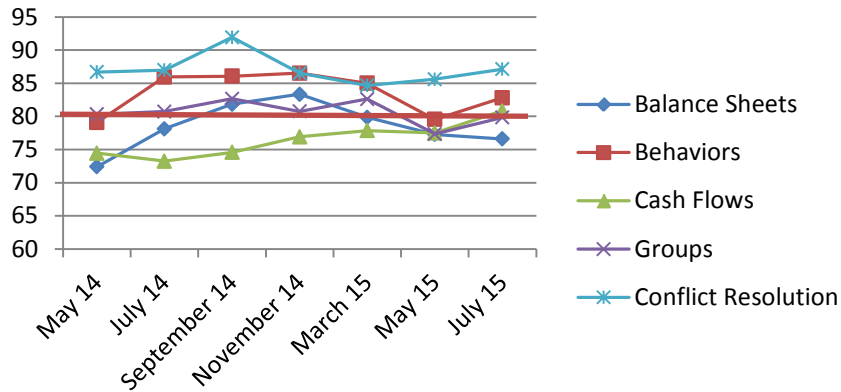
Post - MBA CO Analysis MATH533



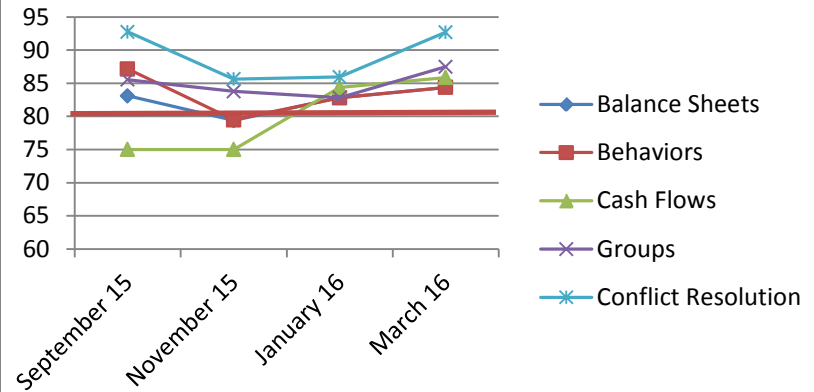
