This Notice Applies to You if: You are a graduate of an associate or bachelor’s degree program from either a DeVry College of New York (DeVry) campus or are a resident of New York and began your program between July 2008 and September 2015.

Reason for the Notice: DeVry has agreed to provide certain educational records to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of New York (NYAG). The NYAG intends to use these records to conduct a redress. DeVry is required under FERPA to notify you that your education records may be produced, this communication constitutes such notice.

Records to be Provided: The information that may be provided to the NYAG includes names, student ID numbers, amount of tuition paid to DeVry less all DeVry-sponsored grants, scholarships or tuition refunds, last known addresses, last known email addresses.
