Program Costs

The following cost information is used to determine financial aid eligibility and may not represent actual out of pocket costs. For instance, the Estimated Room & Board Expense represents a federally required cost of attendance component used in determining financial aid eligibility. Commuting students often incur no additional housing costs with their enrollment.

Placement Rates and Employment Statistics

Massachusetts law requires schools to disclose graduate placement rates and employment statistics. DeVry University's institutional accreditor, The Higher Learning Commission, does not require the University to track, report or verify placement rates. DeVry University collects graduate employment information but does not verify employment therefore for the purpose of this disclosure, DeVry discloses a graduate placement rate of 0% for all programs. DeVry University provides career and employment-seeking advising and assistance. The use of the term "Placement" here does not imply that DeVry University places students with employers at the conclusion of their studies.

Your Loan Debt

Students are obligated to repay student loans borrowed to pay for this program, including interest. If you fail to complete or drop out of the program, you are still obligated to repay any portion of the student loan utilized to date. Failure to repay student loans can affect your credit, future earnings and student loan eligibility.

Loan Nonpayment Statistics

Massachusetts requires institutions to disclose a loan nonpayment percentage. The Massachusetts rate includes those students that were not required to make payments because they continued their studies, were active duty in the U. S. military, were physically disabled or qualified for deferral or forbearance under other terms as established by the U. S. Department of Education. In addition, the nonpayment percentage reflect the novel flexibilities applied to borrower accounts as prescribed in the CARES Act and extended by executive actions through September 30, 2021. As a result, payments are paused, collections are stopped, and interest is waived on all Department of Education-held student loans. Based on this flexibility a large percentage of borrowers are now in forbearance status under the special CARES Act forbearance which impacts the nonpayment percentage. The Massachusetts nonpayment figure for DeVry University is 88.6% for 2017. The official 3-year federal cohort default rate for all institutions in 2017 was 9.7%. For DeVry University that rate was 10.1%.
